

Summer Camp 2011

At Aprende con Amigos our summer camps ensure children “learn with friends” through an exciting, well-balanced and active learning environment. You may enroll your child for all eight weeks or as many weeks as you wish. Each day students have opportunities to explore in our three learning areas: art/music, math/science and language arts/social studies. Each week students will be involved in science experiments, art projects, cooking sessions, dramatic play, creative writing, shared reading, and more! Whether your child is being exposed to Spanish for the first time or is completely fluent, there will be something for everyone at Aprende con Amigos. We hope to see you there!

Up In Space - June 27th—July 22nd

Our first camp is called “Up In Space” and will focus on building both basic Spanish vocabulary such as colors, shapes and numbers, as well as more focused space vocabulary through fun, hands-on experiences. During this camp students will have the opportunity to conduct experiments with light, design works of art using solar energy, create constellations, and have fun creating a space station to pretend in!

Down in the Sea - July 25th-August 19th

Our second camp is called “Down in the Sea” and will focus on building basic Spanish vocabulary and simple sentence structures focused on the sea. Child will have fun making fish prints, creating sand castle works of art, conducting sink or float experiments, and will even be able to observe and record changes as they watch tadpoles grow into frogs! The table below provides more detailed information for each week of camp.

	Week	Dates	Description
Up In Space	1	June 27-July 1 Sun and Light	Children will learn Spanish colors, letters and simple opposites as they have fun manipulating objects on a light table, conducting experiments with light and creating their own solar works of art.
	2	July 5-July 8 Moon & Stars	Children will learn Spanish shapes, letters and numbers by creating a sponge paint moon masterpiece, building phases of the moon with edible foods, graphing constellations, and creating a large mural of Van Gogh’s Starry Night!
	3	July 11-July 15 Our Planets	Children will learn Spanish numbers, colors and shapes by creating their own Planet book , constructing a solar system mobile, observing earth’s rotation using fruits and flashlights, and creating a “Spheres in Space” work of art.
	4	July 18-July 22 Rockets & Spaceships	Children will learn Spanish numbers, shapes and simple describing words by counting down until the launch of water and balloon rockets, building a space shuttle, and will even create a child-sized space station!
Down in the Sea	5	July 25-July 29 At the Beach	Children will learn color and size describing words and practice number identification by sorting shells, creating sand sculptures and a lighthouse landscape, playing beach ball games and observing our classroom tadpoles.
	6	August 1-August 5 Fish & Shellfish	Children will learn shapes, colors, and body part vocabulary by creating and painting patterned clay fish, acting out a Three Hermit Crab Tough story, and observing our tadpoles as they grow and change.
	7	August 8-August 12 Sea Animals	Children will learn and practice shape and letter identification by creating sandpaper sea stars, playing sea animal shape games, creating an origami sea animal diorama and sea animal story book.
	8	August 15-August 19 Water & Life Cycles	Children will learn water cycle and animal life cycle vocabulary by observing and recording the completing of our classroom tadpoles changing to frogs, conducting experiments to learn the three form of water and creating a rain cycle wheel.

Summer Camp 2011

Overview: This summer Aprende con Amigos will run two summer camps in June, July and August for children ages 3 to 5 years old. The first summer camp is entitled, "Up in Space" and will run for four weeks from June 27th to July 22nd. The second camp is entitled, "Down in the Sea" and will run for four weeks from July 25th to August 19th. You may enroll your child for the entire eight weeks, or for as many weeks as you wish. Please note that there is a discount for enrolling in multiple weeks of camp. View the attached schedule for more information about each summer camp. We hope to see you there!

Tuition Includes: A memorable week of small group instruction focused on frequently used Spanish vocabulary, high quality native Spanish speaking teachers and a weekly newsletter highlighting Spanish vocabulary learned each week during camp.

Sibling Discount: Available to siblings who attend the same camp week. First child registers at regular tuition price. Second child takes \$20.00 off Full Day Camp tuition or \$10.00 off a Half Day Camp tuition. Invalid with other discounts.

Multiple Week Discount: Available to students who attend more than one week of one or both camps. The first camp week is offered at regular price tuition. The additional camp weeks include a Multiple Week discount of \$20.00 off each additional Full-Day Camp week or \$10.00 each additional Half-Day Camp week. Invalid with other discounts.

Enrollment/Payment Information: To enroll please submit the summer camp application for enrollment in person, via e-mail or by mail. We will confirm availability and send the appropriate forms to enroll and make payment for your child following our Open House in March. Families enrolled in one or both summer camps will receive an information package about their camp prior to their start date. We will also hold an open house prior to our summer camps to allow children and parents to acclimate themselves to the environment and ask any questions they may have.

Hours of Operation: Drop-off for both half-day and full-day camps is anywhere between 8:00am to 8:30am. The first day you may want to come at 8:00am to allow some extra time for your child to transition. Our first whole-group activity will begin promptly at 8:45am. Half-day pick up is from 12:20-12:40pm. Full-day pick-up may be anywhere from 3:15-5:00pm. We feel having windows of time available for pick-up and drop-off will better accommodate families' scheduling needs.

Lunches and Snacks: All students should pack a healthy lunch according to their dietary needs. Organic and/or all natural snacks will be provided by Aprende con Amigos in the morning and afternoon each day.
